- 8. Reports & Particulars | Mayor, Council, City Manager, Staff, Boards, and/or Commissions
 - Parks & Recreation Director Thraen highlighted the tree projected completed at Miller Park that replaced eight (8) Ash trees with ten (10) new trees. He thanked Arbor League partners, Ken Morse, and Phil Jensen for their continued support of trees in Polk City. He also thanked the Public Works Staff for their assistance with mulch and watering to get the trees ready for winter.
 - Council Member Vogel thanked Ken and Phil for all the volunteer hours they've spent in Polk City making the
 community a Tree City USA community, and wanted to share the impact it makes on her son and all the children of
 Polk City.
 - City Engineer Thornburgh provided an update on the roundabout project, estimating acceptance of the public improvements would be on an Agenda in November.
 - City Manager Huisman reported that the On with Life second reading of the rezoning Ordinance was left off this agenda in error and indicated the second reading would be on the November 13th agenda, and she would recommend Council consider waiving the third reading.
 - Council Member Sarchet acknowledged the work of Ken & Phil with the Arbor League and gave kudos for the efforts of Thraen for all his work too. Acknowledge Tanner and Nate's promotions to officers on the FD.
 - Mayor Karsjen invited the public to Go Polk City event hosting the 2023 City Election Candidates Forum at Luana Bank on October 24th from 6p-8p and will live stream that through the City's You Tube Channel.
